Out of the Darkness

On May 26th, 1883, it was reported that The Village of Moscow streets are now lit by five gas lights and two or three additional ones will soon be erected by enterprising citizens.

By 1914 gas pipes were installed in the Moscow streets and bids were solicited for 18 streetlights at a cost of \$11.26 per light. Unfortunately, by 1920 the natural gas well failed and the streets were dark again.

In 1922 electric light poles and fixtures were installed by the Perry Electric Company and when the connecting line is installed from the Village of Leicester to Perry the Company will supply power. However, the Sterling Salt Company devised a plan to furnish power until the Perry Electric Company was able to.

For the first time the streets of Halite, Cuylerville and the Village of Leicester were lit by electricity. A large celebration was held. An automobile parade was formed at Halite, continued to Cuylerville and then to the Village of Leicester. At the Town Hall a program occurred with speeches and an old-fashioned dance.
